# THE NEW JERSEY FEDERATION OF DOG CLUBS

Pure Breed Resource, Rescue & Canine Service Directory

Congratulations on turning to this directory for guidance in purchasing or adopting a purebred dog. We trust you will find this information beneficial. This directory is just the beginning of the process to find your ideal canine companion.

Before contacting any of the individuals listed in the directory, we strongly urge you to do some preliminary research.

- Evaluate your own circumstances and lifestyle. List the traits you consider essential in finding the perfect canine match for you and your family.
- · Visit the AKC's website to research breeds.

http://www.akc.org/breeds/index.cfm Every breed listed has a parent breed club that sets the standard for that breed. Additional information on the breeds can be found on each parent club's website, including information on health, temperament, and exercise needs. Also check out some of the many books published on finding the right dog for you and books devoted to individual breeds.

This research may save you from falling in love with a breed you find attractive but that might be inappropriate for you. You might even discover that dog ownership is not the answer to your companionship needs.

· Attend dog shows. There are many all-breed and specialty (one breed) shows held in New Jersey annually. The events calendar on the AKC website can tell you when and where shows are being held.

Seek out the exhibitors of those breeds that interest you and ask questions. It is rare that an owner will not take time to extol the virtues of his/her breed. You can expect to hear the negatives as well. Keep in mind that most exhibitors are firmly convinced that their breeds are THE BEST!

· Ask questions about hereditary health issues affecting each breed that interests you. Before making that final decision, learn about these issues. Make sure that the breeder you choose does the health screenings recommended for the particular breed.

Many shows also feature obedience and rally competitions, where you might find additional exhibitors with a different perspective.

Other events licensed by the American Kennel Club include field trials, tracking tests, agility, herding, lure coursing and hunting tests. Many of the breed-specific specialty clubs hold some or all of these events. If you are interested in hunting or field work, by all means consult those clubs.

After doing this research and narrowing your choice to one or two breeds, you are ready to consult this directory. The New Jersey Federation of Dog Clubs is an association of New Jersey dog clubs. Member clubs represent all phases of the purebred dog world. Those listed in this directory are members not of the Federation but of its member clubs. They are the backbone of the purebred dog world in New Jersey.

The directory is arranged alphabetically by breed, and is restricted to breeds eligible to compete in American Kennel Club dog shows. These listings are comprised of breed enthusiasts who do not derive their livelihood from breeding, selling, or training dogs. Rather, it is a labor of love. If you would like more information:

- · Phone for an appointment.
- · Have a list of questions on hand.
- When visiting, make sure you see and interact with the litter's mother as well as the father, if he is on the premises. The parents will give you some idea of what the puppies will grow up to be, both in appearance and temperament.

Question the breeder about health screenings which have been performed on both parents as recommended by the parent club for that breed. You want to minimize the risk of purchasing a puppy that may exhibit genetic health problems in the future.

Puppies are infants, and should appear healthy and active. If you are concerned about the general condition of the puppy, don't buy it. Once you've chosen a puppy make an appointment with your veterinarian to have it checked within a few days.

The breeder should supply:

- The inoculation record, which you should take to the vet so that a record can be established.
- · A pedigree of at least three generations.
- · An AKC registration application. The breeder should have registered the litter with the AKC but it may be up to you to name the puppy, sometimes in consultation with the breeder, and apply for the individual registration. If the breeder already has registered the dog individually, you should receive the certificate of registration. Complete the form on the back to transfer the dog to your name. Don't be fooled by registration papers from other registries. Insist on AKC papers.
- $\cdot$  A written contract outlining the terms of sale and guarantees. Do not buy a puppy without a written contract.

If the responsibilities of raising a new puppy seem overwhelming, you might consider adopting an older dog from one of the purebred rescue services listed in this directory. "Rescue" dogs include strays, dogs surrendered to a shelter or pound or those turned over directly by the previous owner to the rescue service. These dogs normally are evaluated by the rescue service prior to being matched with the best possible home. Many wonderful dogs are being adopted annually and you may just find your next best dog waiting for you there.

These adopted purebred dogs are eligible for a listing number from the American Kennel Club. This number entitles them to compete in obedience, rally, agility and tracking. The New Jersey Federation of Dog Clubs and its member clubs provide this resource to assist you in your quest for the right dog. The individuals listed have provided their information for this directory. Neither the New Jersey Federation of Dog Clubs nor its member clubs are responsible for the actions of anyone listed in this directory.

Not all AKC breeds are listed in this directory. Most parent breed clubs have puppy or breeder referral information on their websites. You can locate other purebred rescue organizations on the internet or through the AKC web site, www.akc.org

# SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

The New Jersey Federation of Dog Clubs has a scholarship program. Funds are accrued throughout the year from the **revenue** of New Jersey Federation Pure Breed Referral and Rescue Directories and from donations. One or more scholarships from \$500 to \$1,500 are awarded. Qualifying student(s) must have completed two years or more of a post-graduate Veterinary program of an accredited University or Veterinary School. The scholarship is available to a New Jersey student attending the Veterinary School.

The deadline for applications is September 1st of every year. The scholarship will be available every year until cancelled.

  - c) Proof of residency in New Jersey
- 2. The Committee will judge the applicant based upon the following categories:
  - a) Financial need
  - b) Academic excellence
  - c) Career goals
  - d) Recommendations
- 3. The Committee will arrive at the consensus winner(s) and a check will then be sent to the College or University for the benefit of the winner(s).




